

Troop 889 Scoutmaster Conferences

In Troop 889, the Scout has the responsibility to initiate contact with a Scoutmaster to arrange for a Scoutmaster Conference (SMC). The SMC must be completed prior to a Board of Review for any rank advancement during the Scout's career. Scouts may request a SMC for Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class and First Class from the list of adult leaders below. Scouts requiring a SMC for Star, Life, Eagle and Eagle Palm may contact the Scoutmaster (current or past), or adult leaders who have completed Wood Badge training. The Scout should contact the Scoutmaster well in advance of the Board of Review to avoid that last minute running around seeking a Scoutmaster to do a SMC.

For Star and Life Scout Rank Advancement SMC's, please follow the procedure below:

1. Prior to scheduling the SMC, the Scout must verify with the Advancement Chair (Mrs. Noren or Mrs. Ruediger) his leadership rank requirements have been fulfilled, e.g., time in rank, leadership, and merit badges earned. Documentation that community service hours have been fulfilled must be available at the SMC;
2. If there are clarifications or changes that need to be made, the Scout needs to contact the Advancement Chair and resolve the issue. Once the issues have been resolved, the Scout can request a SMC;
3. All the requirements for that rank must be signed off in the Scout's Handbook prior to requesting the SMC.

NOTE: The Troop does not track service hours. The Scout is responsible to track and present the hours to the Scoutmaster at the SMC, and then submit those forms to the Community Service SM.
